
PILOT ballpoint pens are available in Standard (Retractable, Cap Slide, Revolving) and Multi-colour (Revolving, Retractable, Lever Slide) types. Please refer to this Use and Care Guide before use.

Standard ballpoint pen

Retractable and Cap Slide Type

•How to use


- (1) The tip comes out by pressing the upper end knob or the cap.
- (2) To retract the tip, press the knob or the cap.



Revolving Type

•How to use

- (1) The tip comes out when the cap is turned in the direction of the arrow.
- (2) The tip retracts when the cap is turned the other way.




How to replace the empty refill

- (1) Unscrew the barrel to detach.
- (2) Pull out the empty refill.
- (3) Insert a new refill.
- (4) Screw the barrel onto the cap firmly.

Removable mouth piece type

- Remove the mouth piece by turning it anticlockwise.
- (2) Pull out the empty refill.
- (3) Insert a new refill.
- (4) Screw the mouth piece onto the barrel firmly.

Barrel Refill




Multi-colour ballpoint pen

Revolving Type (2,3 or 4 colours)

• How to use

The black & red (2colours)/the black, red & blue (3 colours) / the black, red, blue & green (4 colours) tip comes out in turn when the barrel is turned clockwise.



●How to replace the empty refill

- (1) Hold the cap and pull out the barrel.
- (2) Pull out the empty refill. (3) Insert a new refill. (4) Put the barrel on the cap firmly.

Retractable Type (3 or 4 colours)

●How to use

<How to extend the tip>

While seeing the indication mark, press the knob and a tip of the colour of the indication mark comes out.


<How to retract the tip>

Retractable Type: Press the knob again.

Retractable & Button Type: Press the button on clip.
Retractable & Twist Type: Hold the barrel and twist the upper barrel.

●How to replace the empty refill

- (1) Unscrew the barrel to detach.(2) Pull out the empty refill.
- (3) Insert a new refill.
- (4) Screw the barrel onto the cap firmly.





Multi-colour ballpoint pen


Lever Slide Type (3 colours)

•How to use

- (1) Slide the lever and the tip comes out.
- (2) To retract the tip, slide another lever.

•How to replace the empty refill

- (1) Unscrew the mouth piece to detach.
- (2) Pull out the empty refill.
- (3) Insert a new refill.
- (4) Screw the mouth piece onto the barrel firmly.

^{*}The easiest way to find the right ballpoint pen refill is to bring the refill that you usually use as a sample.

Remarks

- Do not use except for writing.
- •Keep away from children.
- ■To prevent ink leakage, never write with the tip upwards.
- Do not give severe shocks such as dropping or hard shaking, as the writing unit or the pencil leads may be damaged.
- ●The stains on the clothes may not wash off because of oil-based ink.
- •Always retract the writing tip after use.
- Do not store in places exposed to direct sunlight or high temperatures.
